Portraits a visual tribute to humanitarians

A remarkable collection of portraits will be unveiled during Lighthouse Youth Services' 40th anniversary celebration Saturday, April 25, at the Hyatt Regency Hotel downtown.

The portraits are of nearly all 67 humanitarians who have been honored as a "Beacon of Light" by Lighthouse over the years. The award honors philanthropy, advocacy and service.

The portraits are by Helen Adams, a longtime Lighthouse supporter and one of Cincinnati's leading portrait photographers.

The visual tribute documents the history of leadership that has helped Lighthouse become a community safety net and a national leader in service to youth and families in crisis.

"When initially asked to photograph all

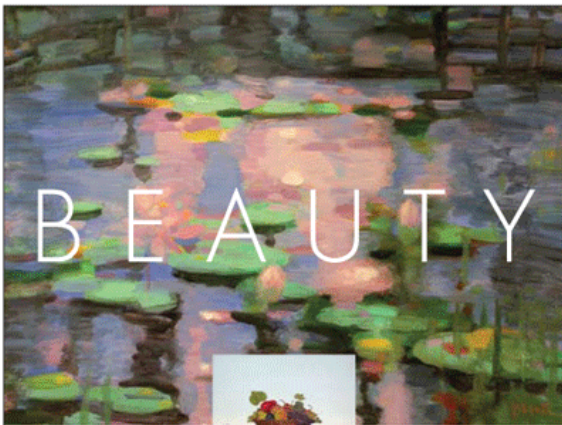
