



WAYS TO SUPPORT YOUTH IN LIGHTHOUSE CARE

Provide a meal or baked goods for youth at one of our residential locations.

Support Lighthouse through Kroger Community Rewards.

Planting flowers or do other yard work.

Help assemble information packets or mailings.

Participate in vision boarding or craft projects with youth.

Host a game night at a shelter, complete with board games, snacks, and fun.

Share a skill with a group of young people like make-up application, knitting, painting, job interviewing, cooking, how to play a musical instrument, etc.

Take a tour of a Lighthouse program or location.

Donate to the Happy Holidays Gift Drive.

Sort and organize donations at the Lighthouse Warehouse.

Become a member of our Young Professionals Committee (21-40 years old) or invite others to join.

Donate new baby supplies, new household items, new clothes, or personal care products.

Assemble a housewarming package for a young person moving into their first apartment, including cleaning products, personal care items, and groceries.

Donate gift cards, including restaurants, haircuts, amusement parks, and groceries.

Provide bus tokens so a young person can get to work or school.

Donate African American hair care products, such as Cantu.

Organize a donation drive for most needed items such as socks, underwear, diapers, baby supplies, or personal care products.

Donate tickets to local events, performances, or attractions for young people in Lighthouse care.

Join a Lighthouse event committee.

Sponsor a child's birthday with a \$50 gift card.

Make snack packs for our Street Outreach Team to distribute to homeless youth living on the streets, including granola bars and water.

Pack hygiene supplies for homeless youth, including shampoo, conditioner, body wash, lotion, and wash rag.



Donate art supplies.

Donate sports equipment/board games to youth in Lighthouse care.

Purchase a zoo, aquarium, or other membership for a foster family.

Volunteer at a Lighthouse event.

Represent Lighthouse at a volunteer fair in your workplace or place of worship.

Invite a Lighthouse representative to speak to your friends, coworkers, class, club, or civic group.

Attend and invite others to an Inside Lighthouse event.

Hire a Lighthouse young adult.

Become a Lighthouse foster parent.

Be an ambassador for Lighthouse. Talk to your friends, family, coworkers, place of worship or civic group about getting involved with Lighthouse.
